

Emergency Drills Report Form 2017-2018

Fire Prevention Act 207 Section 29.19 (as amended effective July 1, 2014) outlines the requirements for schools operating any of grades kindergarten to 12. The specific sections for Fire Drills, Tornado Drills and Lock Downs are listed below.

In addition, the following pertains to ALL DRILLS in Section 19 of the Act:

Sec. 19 (6) A school that operates any of grades kindergarten to 12 shall conduct at least one (1) of the drills required by this section during a LUNCH or RECESS period, or at another time when a significant number of the students are gathered but not in the classroom.

Fire Drills

Sec. 19 (3) A minimum of five (5) fire drills is required for each school year for a school that operates any of grades kindergarten to 12. Three (3) of the fire drills shall be held by December 1 of the school year, and two (2) shall be held during the remaining part of the school year, with a reasonable spacing interval between each drill.

09/19/2017	12:55 p.m.	217	1 min 14 s	During the fire drill on 9/19/2017, the staff, teachers and students exited the building in an orderly and quiet manner with their Emergency Preparedness "red" Book as intended. Teachers took attendance and all students were accounted for. Resolution: Continue to express the importance of evacuating the building in a timely manner, student accountability and the use of the Emergency Procedure Book.
10/19/2017	1:30 p.m.	233	1 min 10 s	During the fire drill on 10/19/2017, the staff, teachers and students exited the building in an orderly and quiet manner with their Emergency Preparedness "red" Book as intended. Teachers took attendance and all students were accounted for. Resolution: Continue to express the importance of evacuating the building in a timely manner, student accountability and the use of the Emergency Procedure Book.

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Lock Down Drills

Sec. 19 (5) A minimum of three (3) drills in which the occupants are restricted to the interior of the building and the building secured is required for each school year at a school that operates any of grades kindergarten to 12. At least one (1) of these drills shall be conducted by December 1 of the school year, and at least one (1) shall be conducted after January 1 of the school year, with a reasonable spacing interval between each drill (please refer to the Act for more info regarding these drills)



11/15/2017	12:25 p.m.	219	Chavez Scrivner	The lockdown occurred at 12:25 p.m. with the announcement over both the P.A. system and the walkie talkies that an intruder was in the building and that all classes should immediately go into lockdown mode. During the lockdown the following incidents were observed: 1) All classroom doors were locked as indicated by the school's lockdown procedures and protocols. 2) All students and staff were out of sight when looking through the classroom doors; all classes appeared to be empty. A member of the administration team knocked on several classroom doors asking to be let in. All classrooms remained silent and appeared to be empty. Resolution: Continue to have professional development to explain and discuss the correct procedures for safely locking down a classroom.

Tornado Drills

Sec. 19 (4) A minimum of two (2) tornado safety drills is required for each school year. At least one (1) of the tornado safety drills shall be conducted during March of the school year.
